

In Brief

Download the compressed *WinDoor 12.5* file from the OzCAD web site, expand, copy the plug-ins to the designated location, copy the workspaces to the Workspaces folder, launch VectorWorks then select the appropriate workspace. **Note that the plug-ins now go in your User folder.**

Detailed Instructions

Step 1 – Download the Software

Download the appropriate *WinDoor 12.5* archive [Mac or Windows] to your desktop and if necessary, uncompress so that you have a folder called *WinDoor Folder* in that location. Open the folder and position it to one side of your monitor.

Step 2 – Install the WinDoor Plug-ins

Quit VectorWorks if necessary, open your hard drive [Mac] or My Computer [Windows] and copy the *WinDoor 12* folder and the *OzCAD Preferences* folder to the following location:

Note that you can use *Copy* and *Paste* for this operation.

Step 3 – Install the Workspace

Locate the *VectorWorks 12.5* folder on your computer, which in a typical installation, will be in the *Applications* folder [Macintosh] or the *Program Files* folder [Windows]. Open this folder and position it so that you can see the *Workspaces* folder. Return to the *WinDoor Folder*, open the

Mac Workspaces folder or the *Windows Workspaces* folder, then copy the appropriate workspace from this location to the *VectorWorks 12.5 Workspaces* folder. Note that you can use *Copy* and *Paste* for this operation.

You can alternatively skip this whole step and use the *VectorWorks 12.5 Workspace Editor*, to manually add the six *WinDoor 12.5* items to your favourite workspace. Look for them in the *OzCAD Pty Limited* category in the left hand pane of the *Workspace Editor*.

Step 4 – Install the unlock Key

Demo version users ignore this step. Now install the unlock key that was emailed to you by copying it to the *OzCAD Preferences* folder, which is in the *Plug-ins* folder installed in Step 2.

Step 5 – Switch Workspaces

Launch VectorWorks then go to the *Tools/Workspaces* menu and choose one of the workspaces that ends with *WinDoor 12.5*.

You are now ready to use the *WinDoor 12*. Please take the time to read the User Guide and/or watch the QuickTime® movies on our web site.

Demo Version Limit

The demo version of *WinDoor 12.5* only permits two *WinDoor* objects per file. This includes objects that have been converted to symbols or ungrouped and will also limit the use of the *Draw WinDoor Objects* tool to just two components. If you purchase the software, a small unlock file will be sent by email to remove this restriction.
